

CSCI104 – Essential Computing I will provide your course materials via a program called Inclusive Access. This service enables the Campus Bookstore to offer students instant access to the required course materials for this class at a **substantially discounted price!**

What does this mean for you, the student? It means you immediately have access to your digital course materials through D2L - but you will incur a charge on January 29th if you do not opt out of the program. Login to your D2L course and follow the instructions within the course to access the digital materials.

****You will receive emails from “Edinboro Bookstore”, please read them as they will contain important information about accessing your materials, how to opt out of the program (if you want to) and when you will be charged for materials.***

On January 29, 2019, your student account will be charged \$47.25. If, for some reason, you decide you **DO NOT** want to purchase these required materials from the Campus Bookstore, follow these instructions to opt out of the program by the **January 25th deadline:**

- 1) Log into D2L and navigate to your digital material (in the content area for the course)
- 2) Click on the “RedShelf eBook” link
- 3) Click on the “view course materials” button
- 4) Scroll to the bottom of the page and select “I want to opt out of access to all required materials for this course” and follow the prompts

If you opt out by the **January 25th deadline**, your student account will not be charged – **HOWEVER, you will no longer have access to your digital course materials as of January 29th AND you will still need to purchase a hardcopy of the book at the bookstore.**
